
Pollution Around Us



The natural environment means the sum of all living and non-living things around us – what we see, breathe, hear and includes the place we live in. You must have heard the word 'pollution'. It means contamination of environment by harmful substances.

There are three kinds of pollution:

1. Factories and vehicles make the air dirty with the black smoke they sometimes let out. This is called air pollution. We breathe in this air and it is bad for our health.





2. Human activities like throwing garbage or factory wastes and bathing of animals in rivers make the water dirty. This is called water pollution.

3. Sometimes, vehicles and machines in factories make a lot of noise. This is called noise pollution.
