Table Manners

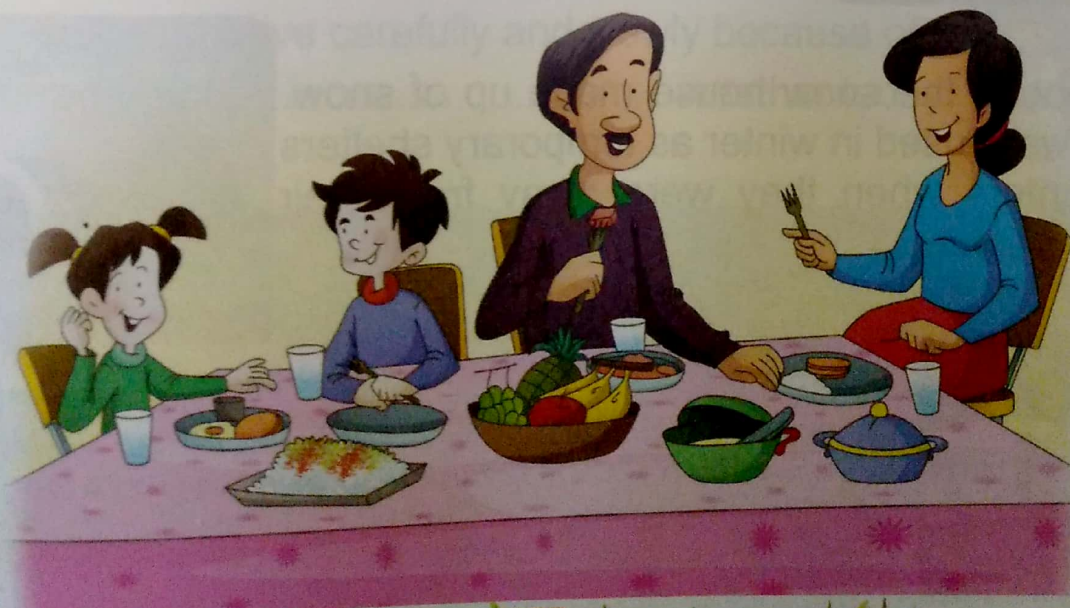


When you are sitting at the dining table and eating your food, you should follow the table manners.

Types Of Houses

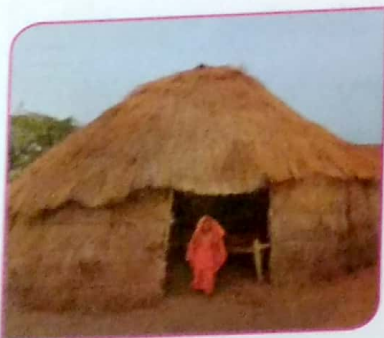
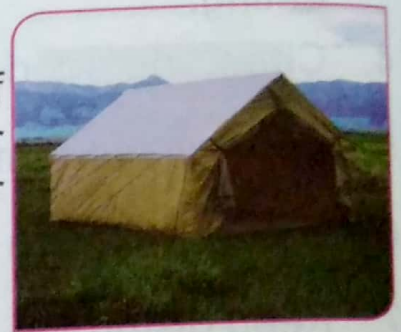


We need a house to live in because a house protects us from heat, cold, rain, thieves and wild animals. People make different types of house in different places.



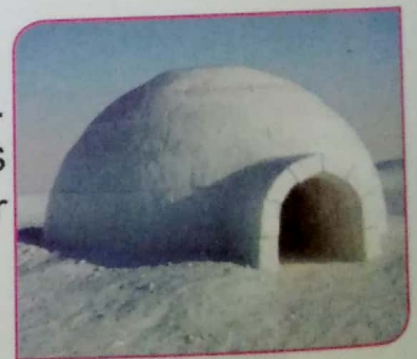
Houseboat is a kind of boat which is designed to be used as home. Houseboat comes in various styles and some are floating whereas others are anchored or tied to the land.

Know Your Capital - Delhi

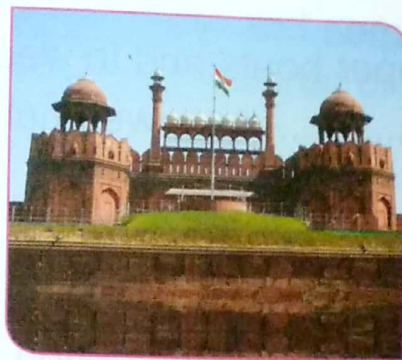
