

## Top Ways To Go Green

If you want to help your planet, do not think that there is nothing that can be done. This means that you can do so much and probably more than you think that you can. Here are some easy ways to go green.



Give up bottled water: Billions of plastic bottles are sold annually in the world and more than 90% of this plastic is not recycled. Many water bottle companies use municipal water sources (i.e tap water). So, you can save resources and money by drinking water from your home filtration system with a reusable water bottle.

**Green your transportation:** Bicycling, walking, carpooling or riding the bus are the best ways to save environment. For long distances use the train or other public transport.





Keep electronics out of trash: Keep your cellphones, computers, and other electronics as long as possible. Donate or recycle them responsibly when the time comes. E-waste contains mercury and other toxics and is creating an environmental problem.

Use less electricity: Do you know that many electronics consume energy even when they appear to be off or in standby mode. It can add as much as 10 percent to your electricity bill. Try to unplug things like chargers, microwaves and computers when not in use.





Go Digital: Use online services to pay bills and booking tickets. This system not only makes sure that you waste less paper but also save your time of standing in banks and payment queues.

Using rechargeable batteries: The normal batteries we use are thrown away after use. But, these batteries are not disposed of after a single use. This method also saves the money and the environment.





Avoid using polythene bags: Avoid buying items packaged in plastic. Use cloth shopping bags, polythene bags are non-biodegradable and highly dangerous for land and water resources.

Use Energy efficient light bulbs: Try to switch your bulbs to energy efficient (CFLs ) or LED bulbs. Though they may be a little more expensive, but they are worth it, because they can last up to five times longer than regular light bulbs and are very bright so you won't need to turn on as many lights.
