Special classes were held for Class 9th, 10th & 11th in the Winter Vacation. Two Pre-University-Exams and over 10 practice tests for each subject were held for Class 10th. Separate workshops were organized on stress

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## ***Encouragement***

Most of us don't mind being told of our faults, if the critic is generous enough to mince in a few of our virtues as well.

It's a normal reaction to defend ourselves and our behavior when someone criticizes us, even if we secretly recognize that what we're being told is correct. However people who have achieved a lot in their life are those who have learned to set aside their emotions and learn from criticism of others, even if the message is unpleasant. If you find yourself being evaluated by someone else, keep reminding yourself that this criticism is not a personal attack and on the contrary can assist you in your growth. Control your emotional reactions and acknowledge the useful ideas even though you may dislike the manner in which the information is delivered. Remember content of a book is more important than the design of its cover!

However those criticizing a person must also understand that often praise is necessary along with criticism. Remember criticism never works alone.
